- * develop written methods for all four operations and our knowledge of number and place value, fractions, measures, shape, position & direction, tables and



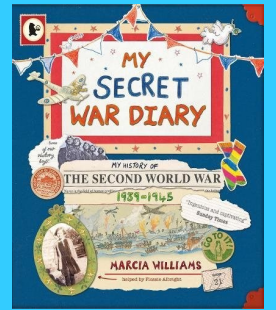
