

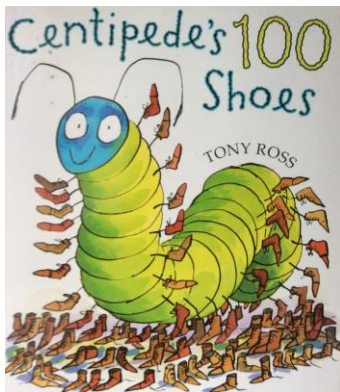
**** Ashton First School News ****

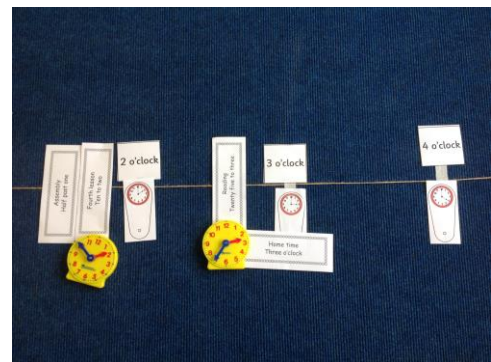

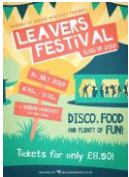
