

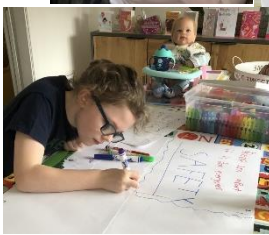
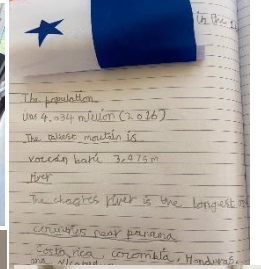
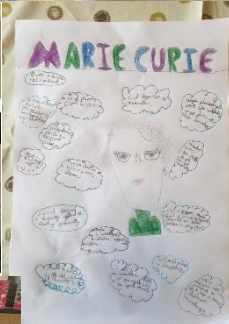
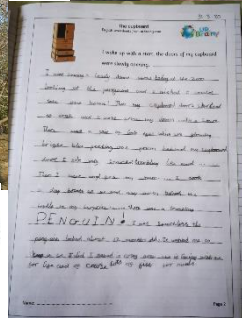
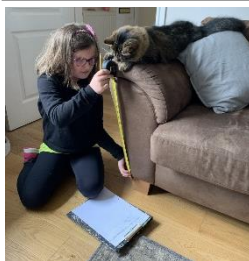
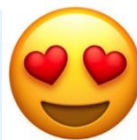


Willow's Home-schooling Newsletter
